Ball technical information

The ball plays its own important role in the game and therefore the state it is in is vitally important. Its surface, inflation and grip are essential elements for adequate use.

Basic Elements:

- Made of leather, vinyl or any other smooth material that does not make it easy to grip the ball.
- Round.
- Diameter: 33 cm (13 in)
 - o not less than 30.5 cm (12 in) and no more than 35.6 cm (14 in)
- Inflated to the pressure set by the manufacturer.
 - Avoid playing with an underinflated ball
